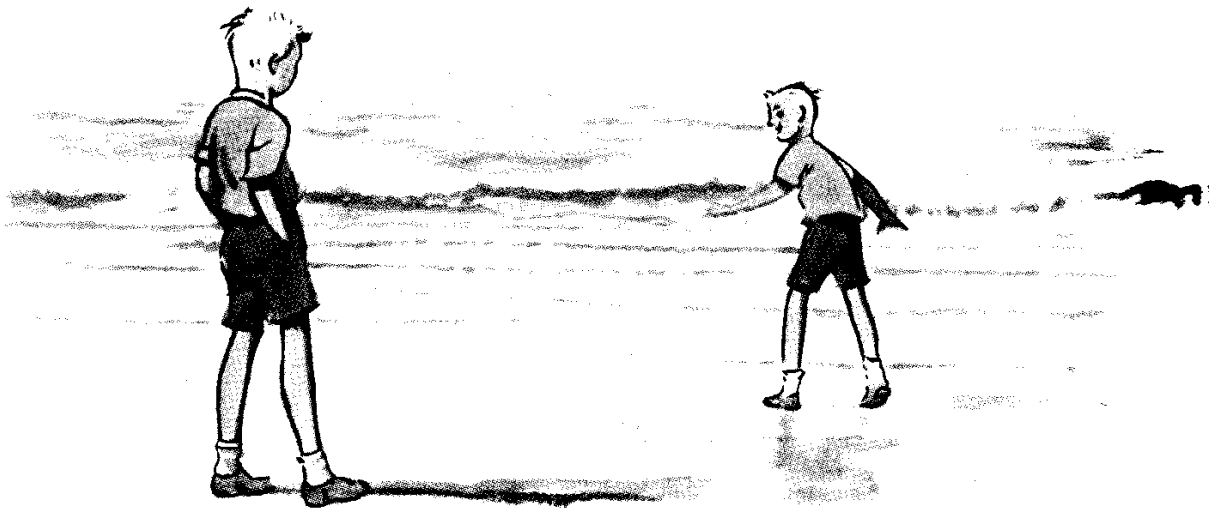

“Hurry up, Billy,” called Bobby, as he ran down to the edge of the waves.

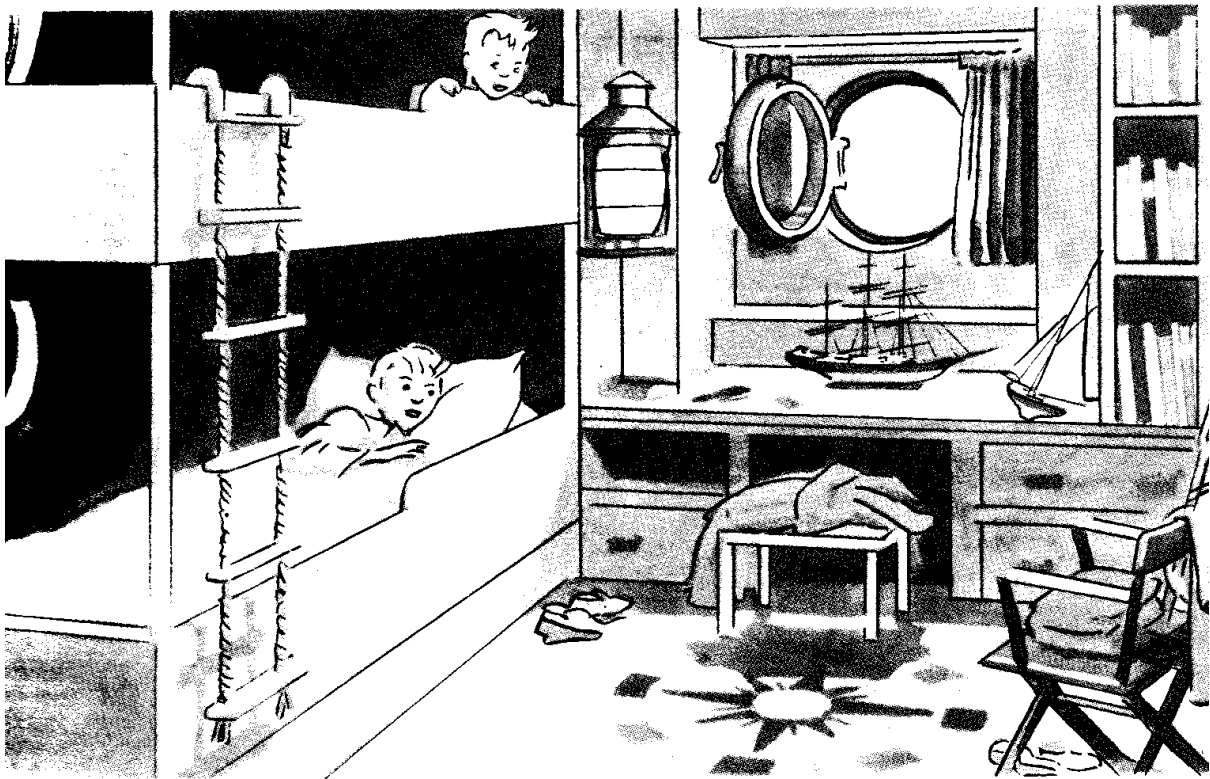
But Billy stood for a time to watch the long waves rolling in. The waves curled over until they broke, and then the white foam ran up the sand.
