4. What would you like to give your mother for Mother's Day?



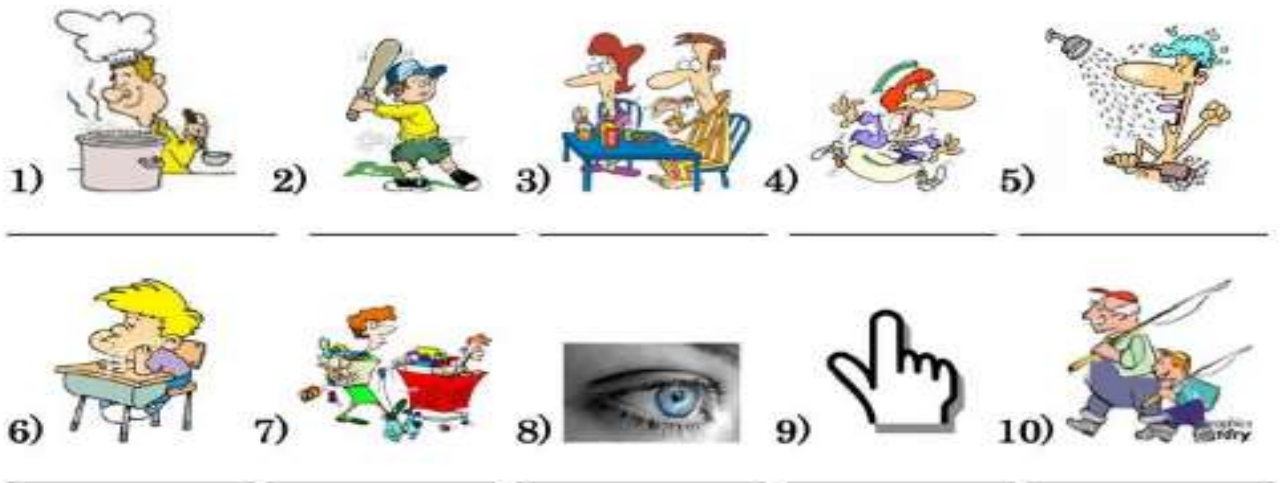
